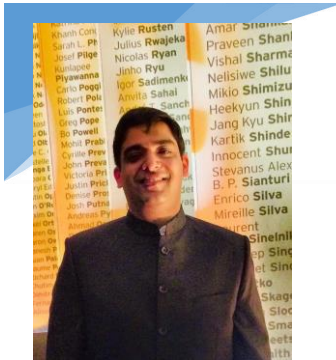
Ramanan Raghavendran

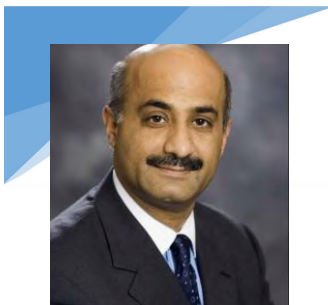

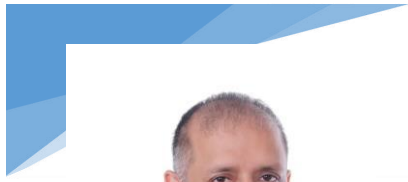


Vineet Bajpai
