Every year, the Interact Club supports non- governmental organizations like Goonj, Red Cross, PFA and more. Doing everything in their power to contribute and help out.

A brief outline of the year activities are stated below:

- Interact Club is associated with Goonj , a non-governmental organization which undertakes disaster relief, community development and humanitarian aid. Interact Club collected contributions from students which included old but reusable materials like clothes, books, shoes, bags etc. a plethora of students contributed to the organization voluntarily.



- The Interact Club initiated an awareness program for protection against Cyber Crime and Harassment, wherein they discussed how to make Internet a safe place for students along with the negative impacts of certain games, websites.
- Armed forces Flag Day was celebrated in school on 7th December 2017 by selling tickets of Rs.10 each the money was collected and sent to the association for war veterans who have dedicated their lives to protect citizens like us.
- The Interact Club attended the **DISTRICT INTERACT LEADERSHIP ASSEMBLY (DILA)**, organized by Rotary Club. It was an interactive session with dignitaries from various walks of life and our school performed a street play on the 'Atrocities of the Caste System' which was deeply appreciated.



- The members of the Interact Club volunteered at People for Animals (PFA) on a regular basis. PFA is India's largest animal welfare organization founded by Maneka Gandhi in 1992. The primary aim of the organization is to rescue birds and animals and ensure that they are adopted by good homes. The members from the Interact Club volunteered help in cleaning of units, grooming of animals, cooking, while they also pamper them and be of immense help in the medical units.



- The Interact Club of Air Force Bal Bharati was applauded by the Rotaract Club, Southend Delhi and was awarded a special mention in their monthly newsletter, the Southend Surkhiyaan. Some of the students of the school which included Nunika Khungar (vice-president of the Interact Club) were presented with the Women's Education and Empowerment award by Women's Agency for Generating Employment (WAGE).



- The Interact Club had a road safety awareness initiative as well in which quizzes about safety rules were distributed to the students of sixth and seventh grades. Following that another awareness campaign was introduced regarding the negative influence and effects of crackers.

- A poster making competition was held in lieu of communal harmony which has had a very positive aftereffect.



- The Interact Club has been collaborating with The Indian Red Cross Society which aims at promoting Health and Care of vulnerable people and communities along with providing relief in times of natural disasters.



- Driven by the hazardous air quality index in Delhi, the members also took initiative of sensitizing the children of the ill-effects of bursting Firecrackers, and encouraged them celebrate cracker free and eco-friendly Diwali, the Festival of Lights
