SHRAMDAAN HOUR BY CLASS-3

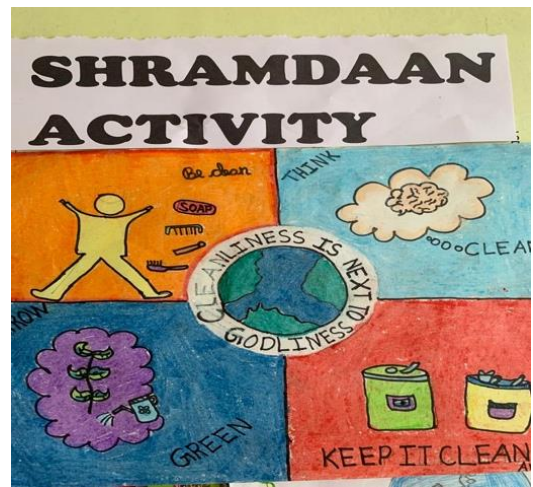
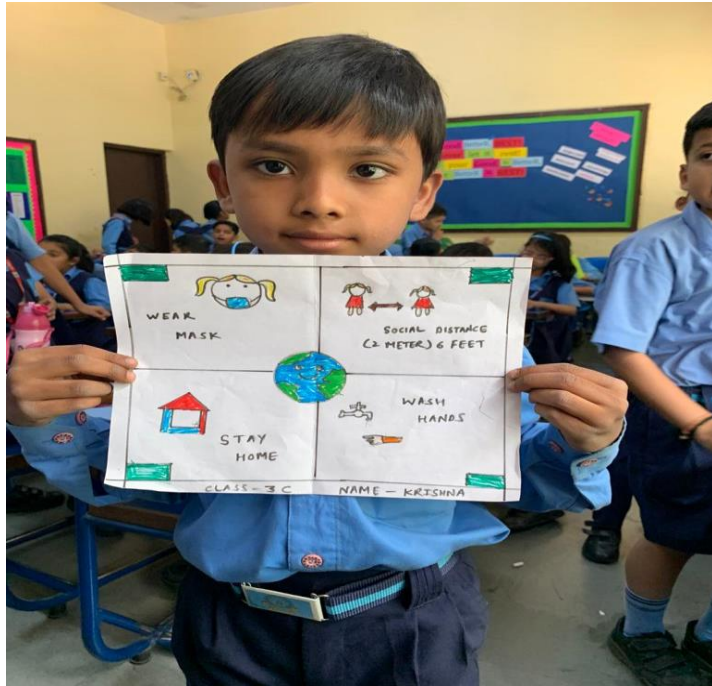
