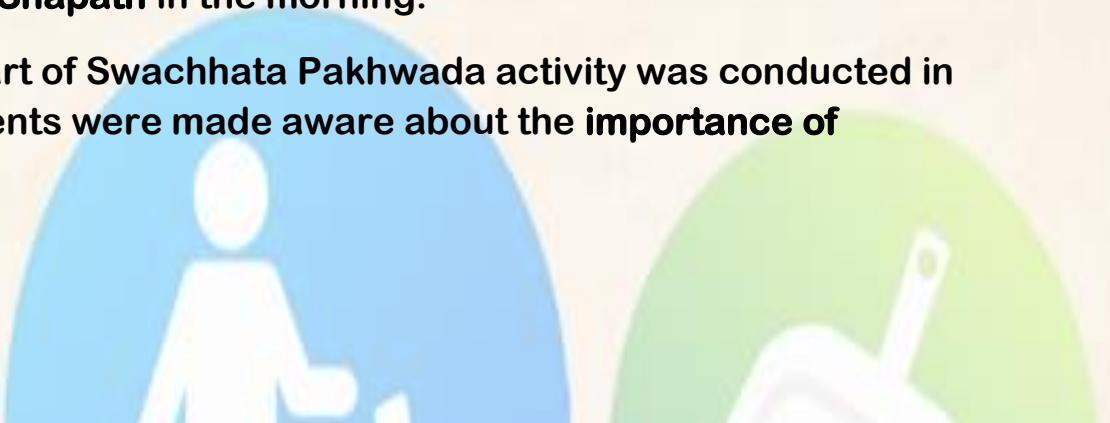




CLASS II

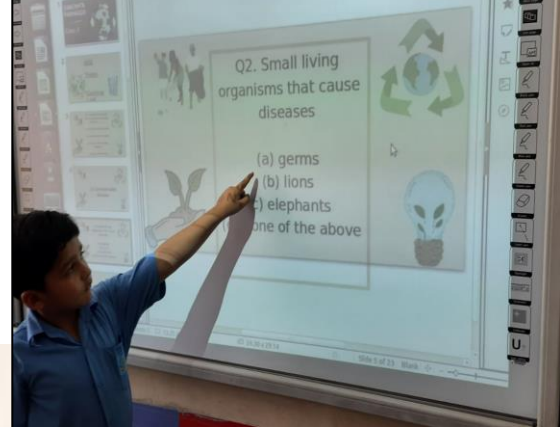
The aim is to create awareness amongst all students about cleanliness and hygiene. The students of class 2 took an oath – **Swachhata Shapath** in the morning.

cleanliness and personal hygiene. All students actively participated in the activity.



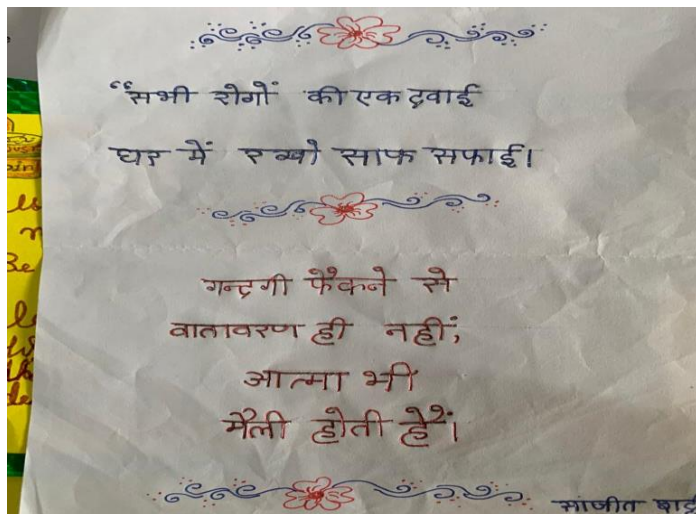


CLASS III

The students of class 3 took – Swachhata Shapath in the morning. Students wrote beautiful slogans on cleanliness and hygiene.



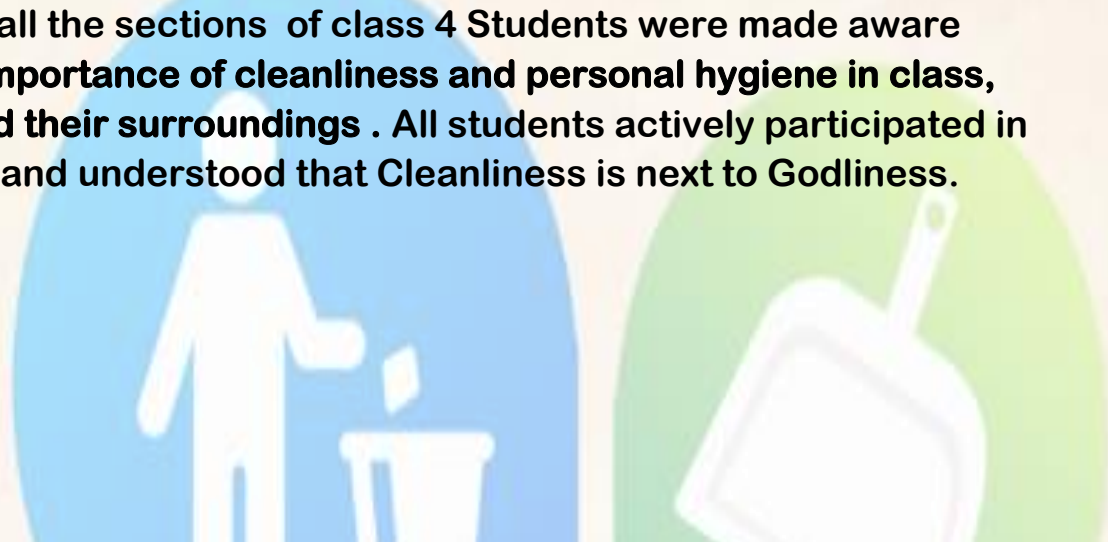




CLASS 4

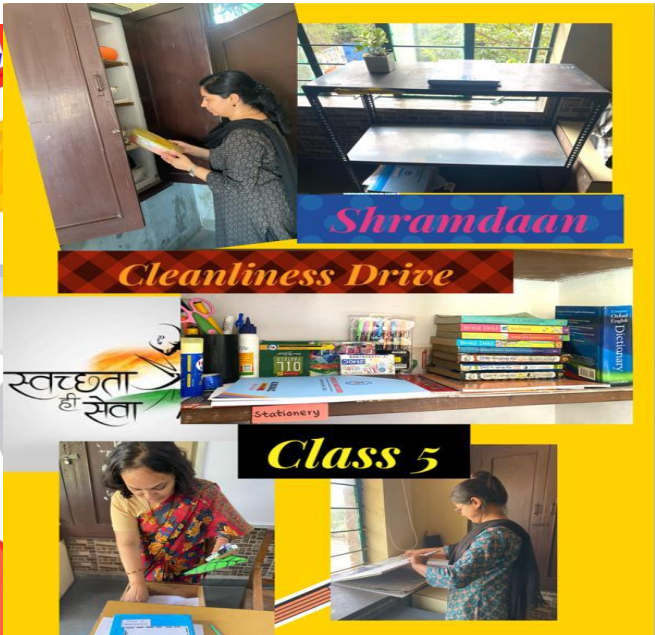
Students cleaned their classroom tables, chairs, windows, doors etc. and actively participated in the cleanliness drive and understood the importance of cleanliness.
